FUN SHOPS: activities consist of Crafts (usually one craft per day is produced), Nature (i.e. nature study, localized hike), and Spiritual (i.e. light bible story/discussion). **WEEKLY HIKE:** will be age appropriate and Counselor led. Bag lunches are provided. This activity provides a real sense of achievement for the campers! **GROUP ACTIVITY:** may vary to include activities such as, interactive games, archery, geocaching, wide area games, talent show, dance, movie, (more info. below) **FUN MEAL:** may vary to include activities like Monks Meal (no speaking & some type of head cover, i.e. a hoodie or towel), Dress Up (a costume can be worn), No Hands (self explanatory), Kitchen Utensil (no fork/spoon – only large kitchen utensils are used to eat with), Pajama Meal, etc.

WATER SPORTS: may consist of water games, a hike to a close by lake or swimming hole/jumping rock, or a hike & 'creek crawl' to a close by natural rock waterslide. **TALENT SHOW:** time permitting, are either individual or cabin wide group talents, usually small skits, or individual camper talents.

CLEAN UP: groups are assigned by cabins and involve clearing tables after meals, sweeping floors, doing dishes, cleaning washrooms & emptying garbage.

INTERACTIVE GAMES: may vary to include games like, Capture the Flag, Capture the Counselor, Group Hide & Seek, etc.
